Take care when sending in a resume' style application to make sure your information is organized in the format of our application. Failure to follow the order of our application and answer all questions asked could result in your application receiving lower scores.

Essay *** NO NOT summarize your HS experience as a reason for considering you for a scholarship! Your application gives us that. Tell us what makes your current path one that we should consider awarding a scholarship. What is it about this path that inspires passion for your future? (being a 13 yr Roughneck is not a reason to be granted a scholarship)

When listing your HS activities be sure to include the number of years participated. Also include activities outside of WOHS (swimming, cheer, karate, clubs, music, rodeo, etc). Be sure to highlight your honors and awards as well as any offices/titles held. Do not assume the board knows you. We don't.

Community Service/Church/Volunteer quidelines - if your purpose lies in service/volunteerism, let your light shine here! You must list whether service was done as part of a group or individually. Also, include how often performed and what tasks performed. Failure to include this information could result in no credit given for this section of the application. (helping out twice a year in the church nursery does not count as volunteer service)

Work Experience – for many, this will offset why you may not have been involved as much in school activities. Explain your work experience (where and for how long) and tell your responsibilities and hours worked per week or per month. List any promotions or accolades earned. (Babysitting a couple of times a month is not a job. Mowing yard for a neighbor or others a couple of times is not a job. These situations only count as a job when done consistently over a specific period of time.)

Each and every application will be unique. Some will be strong in GPA and HS activities but may not have had time for job experience. Some will be strongly focused on job experience and headed for a trade/technical school. Others may be less involved but highly motivated towards service and have a planned path accordingly. Each of these candidates/applicants are qualified for scholarships. It will be up to the applicant to put their best representation of his/her self for the scholarship board to see. So make us proud!!
